

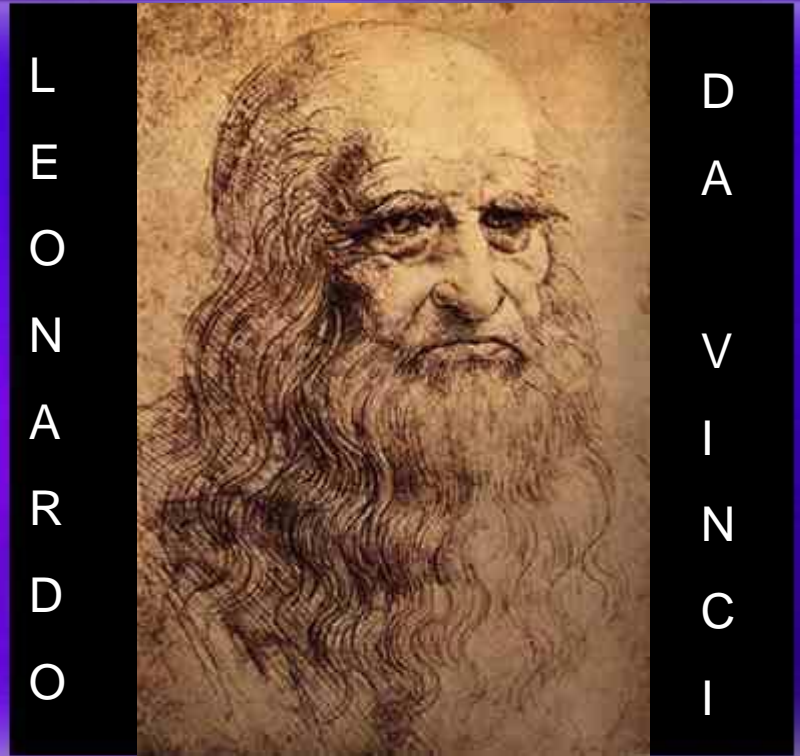
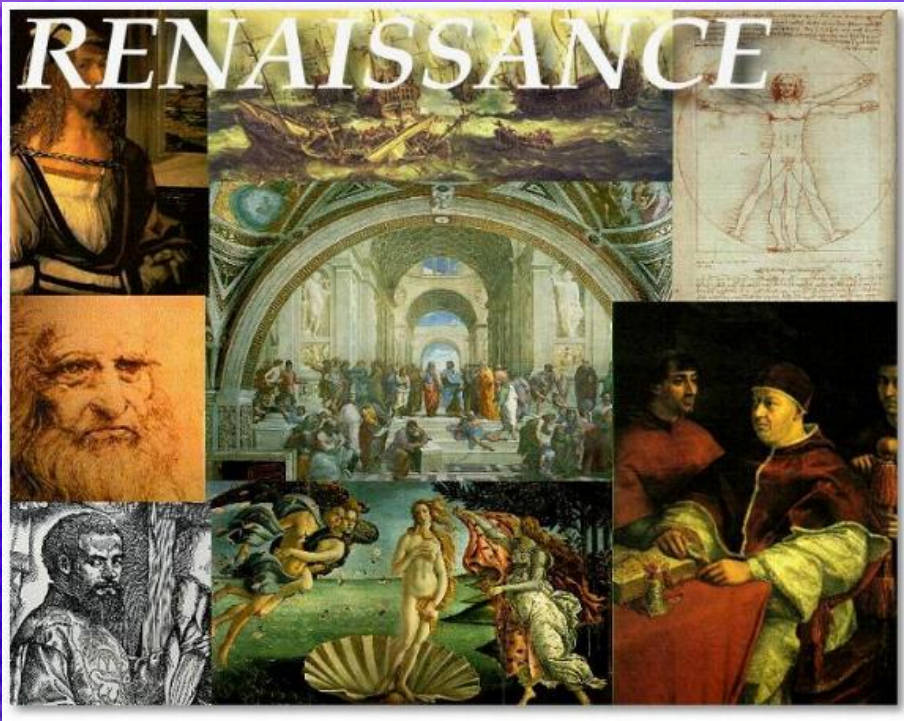

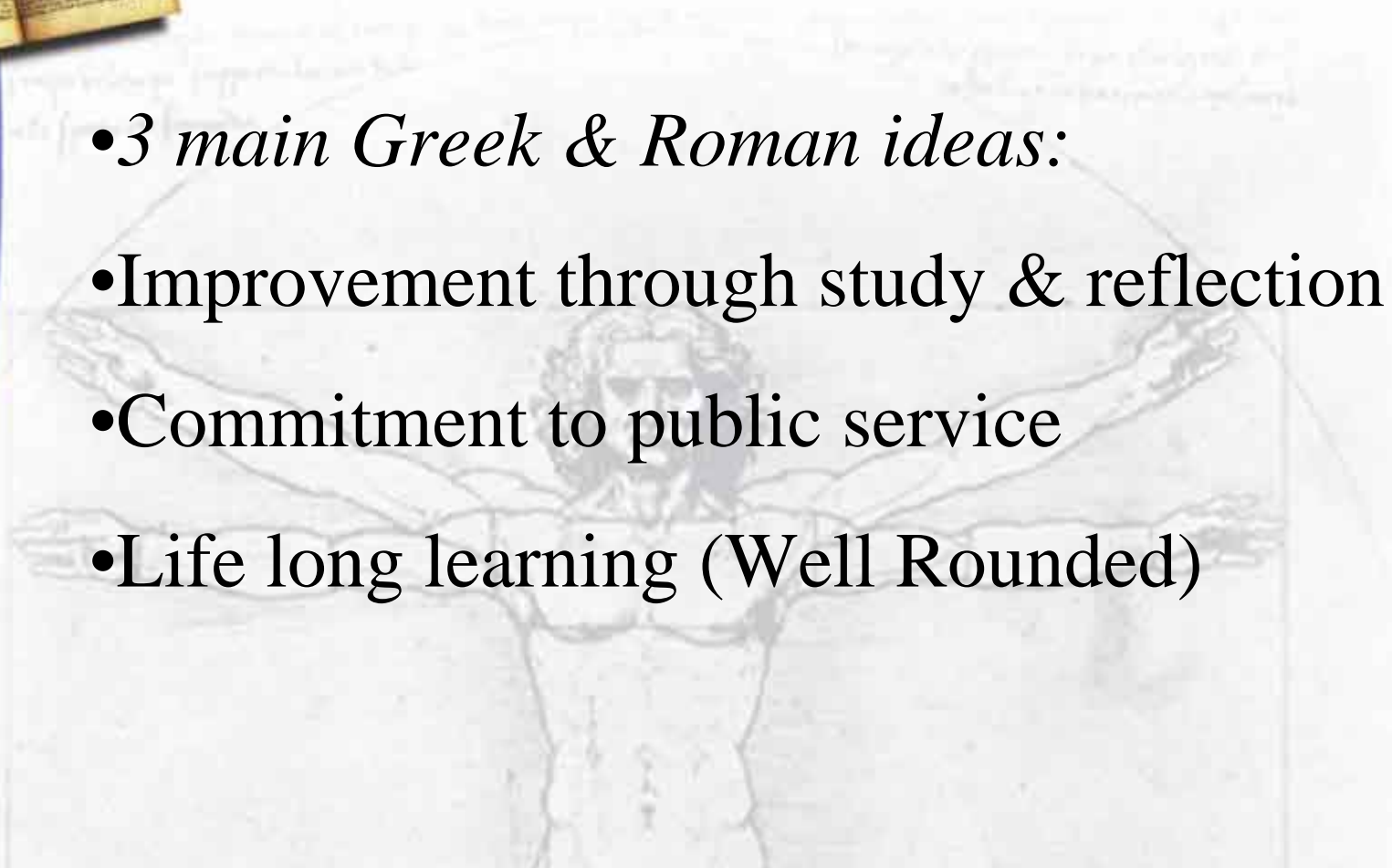

# Humanism



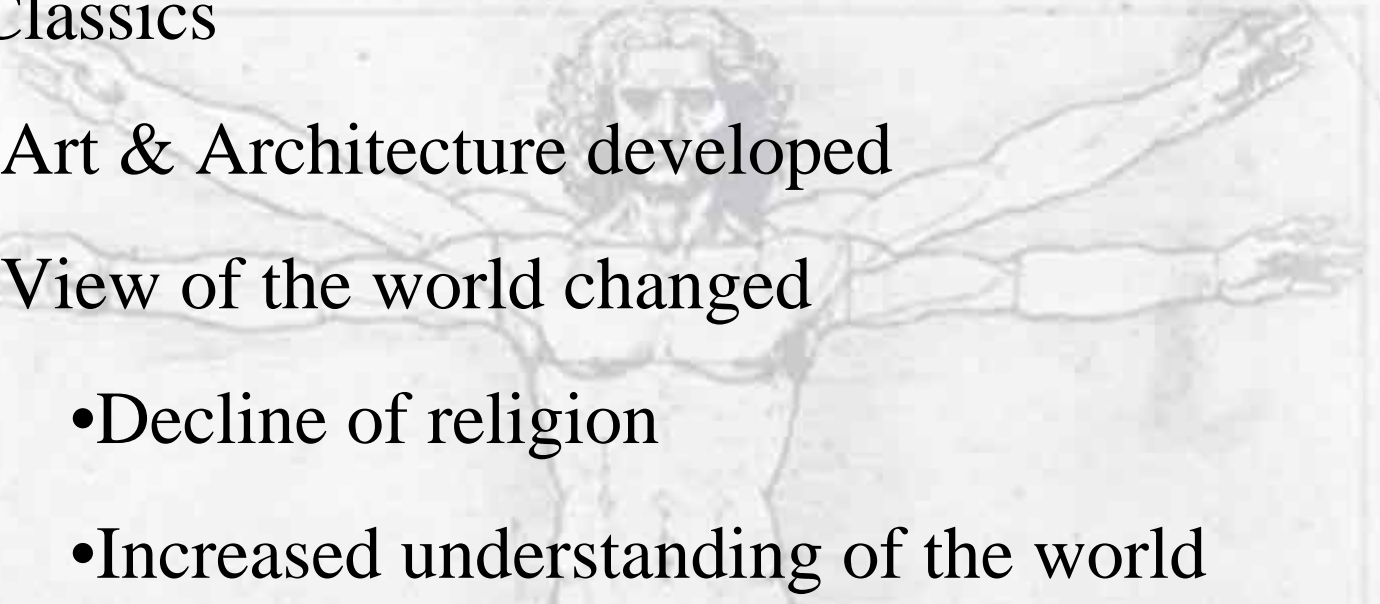
- *3 main Greek & Roman ideas:*

- Commitment to public service
- Life long learning (Well Rounded)



# Intellectual & Economic Changes



- Education increases
- *Humanists*-Concern with the Greek & Roman Classics
- Art & Architecture developed
- View of the world changed
  - Decline of religion
  - Increased understanding of the world



# Growth of the Merchant Class

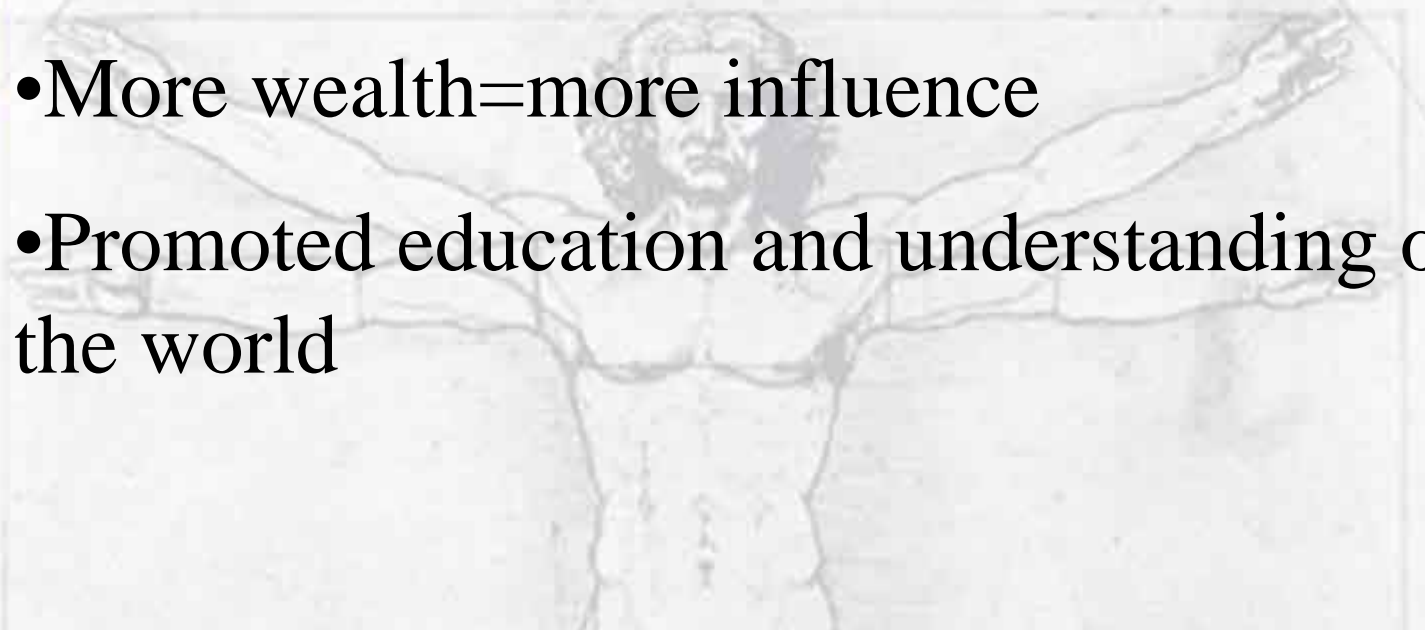


- Demand for goods and services increases
- Manufacturing centered in towns & cities
- Bankers & moneychangers grew wealthy
- Increased focus on education
  - Math, Reading, & Culture

# Growth of the Merchant Class



- Merchant & Commercial Class grew in power
- More wealth=more influence
- Promoted education and understanding of the world



# Resurgence of the cities



- Italian *City-States* controlled government
- *City-States* ruled by wealthy families or individuals
- The families influenced the growth of learning, arts, and architecture of the city

- Controlled international banking
